


Westcott Spiderlites at FLAAR facilities in Guatemala.




Westcott softboxes being used for nature photography in BGSU Greenhouse.



Here is the 3-lamp version of the Westcott fluorescent system, as used at BGSU in their College of Technology.





Here are the Westcott Spiderlites, they were set up with the softboxes.




Here are the Westcott Liteboxes, Spiderlites as they arrived to our building.
